In contrast, qualitative research methods have characteristics that are more subjective, phenomenological, inductive, inner behaviour and holistic.

Also, it includes those that discuss the methods used in doing so. Qualitative research methods have several application concepts that must be applied in the research to be conducted. Technique Collecting the data

The author uses interview and documentation techniques for data collection in this qualitative research. According to (Sugiono, 2020), interviews are a technique used to obtain information about a problem that must be researched through asking questions to participants. Interviews were conducted with ten informants from the younger generation in the surrounding environment. Where five sources were interviewed directly, and five people were interviewed online. In this research, the author asked the sources 12 questions. Meanwhile, according to (Sudaryono, 2019) documentation is a way of obtaining data directly from the research site,

including books, documentaries, and relevant research data. In this case, the author uses documentation in the form of recordings and writings from interviews with respondents.
